Dear East Dubuque Resident

The City of East Dubuque has been working on a solution to providing sanitary sewer service to your area. We began working on this issue when we were approached by some of your neighbors who were dealing with septic issues. The first step involved design and then we moved on to funding alternatives. We were fortunate to receive a \$2.2 million grant from the State of Illinois to offset some of the expenses. We recently went through a bidding process which resulted in higher bids than we wanted. Based on requests from some of you, we have decided to host an informational meeting to discuss the project and the current status.

The meeting will be on Tuesday, August 16th at 6:00 pm. Because of the number of invitations we are sending, we have worked with East Dubuque School officials to host the meeting at the High School. We will have representatives of the city and our engineering services available to make a presentation to you. We will then have a question-and-answer session.

We look forward to this opportunity to have a positive discussion about the future of municipal services in your area.
